



## Freemasons discover how donation is supporting vital research

Cambridgeshire freemasons visited the Department of Clinical Neurosciences at the University of Cambridge to cast an eye over research into neurodegenerative disease which is being carried out by PhD students Sarah Shipley and Annabel Curle.

Their research has benefitted from a donation from the Masonic Charitable Foundation (MCF) Cambridge Scholarships, facilitated by the Cambridge Trust, which has provided more than £200,000 of funding to bring them to Cambridge.

Cambridgeshire freemasons Bharat Khetani and Nigel Williams, both retired doctors,

were especially interested in the technology used in the labs and the potential medical impact of the work.

They were accompanied by Mark Shields, who is coordinating Cambridgeshire freemasons' festival 2023 which aims to raise nearly £1,000,000 for the Masonic Charitable Foundation.
